By making our home a temple and assume every family member in the form of Parmatma, we kindly request you all to participate in the birth celebration.

For the celebration, if possible, a photo or an image of God is required to be placed in a thaali and kept in an appropriate place in the home. The Puja will be performed whilst seated in front of the photo or the idol of Prabhuji. Following the Puja, ringing of the bells, Janma (Birth) Celebration Bhakti, Aarti and Mangal Divo will be performed.

### Items required for Puja:

- Vasakshep (or sandalwood powder/saffron rice)
- Incense – Dhoop
- Divo
- Matchbox
- Rice
- Fruit
- Naivedya (Mithai or Saakar)
- Loose change/money (for Puja and Aarti)
- Thaali and Danko (or a bell)

Please Note: If for any circumstance, any of the items stated are not available, then the Puja can still be performed with great devotion. We shall commence the Puja at 10.30am. For World Peace, please try to chant 108 (one Mala) Navkar Mantra or as many as possible with the family prior to commencing the Puja.

Let us all take this golden opportunity and celebrate the birth of Shri Mahavir Prabhu joyfully in our own home.
