Oshwal Association of the UK has been in existence for over 5 decades in the United Kingdom. We have come a long way from our early days where the community spirit was more based on survival in a then foreign country, to a more thriving community today, with four community centres and nine areas.

Our Areas have been the backbone of our community. It is the work that the areas do with our members, that keeps our community spirit alive. Today, we have four areas that run a weekly Saturday School teaching our mother tongue, Gujarati and impart vital cultural knowledge that helps our younger generation stay connected with our roots. We also have five areas that run weekly youth clubs that help keep our younger generations connected with our community through organised activities. Our youth and middle-aged members will also have professional development, education, career advice and health and wellbeing events delivered by the specialists in local areas. In addition, there are regular weekly and monthly activities for the elder generations such as yoga, luncheons and other activities which allow the elder generations to also remain connected with our community. With the inception of the Oshwal Street Support Network, we will be able to further develop support services for our members who are now frail and vulnerable and cannot attend the in-person activities that we host.

To ensure that we are able to offer the care and support to our youth and our elders, we are now launching the Oshwal Welfare Fund (OWF). This scheme will subsume the current £120 scheme (the existing donors will have the opportunity to increase their donations should they wish to do so). The OWF will give the entire donation to the Area to ensure that we can fully or partly fund all its welfare activities. Areas will provide details of where the funds have been spent by them at the Annual General Meetings.

Our objective is to build a caring and supporting community which can provide services for all our members and ensure that our member base expands and always remain connected with our community. Please help us deliver these services, events and activities by joining the OWF. Your contributions will enrich our community and make it strong and vibrant.
