“Om Hrim Shri Ajitnath Parmeshthine Namah”

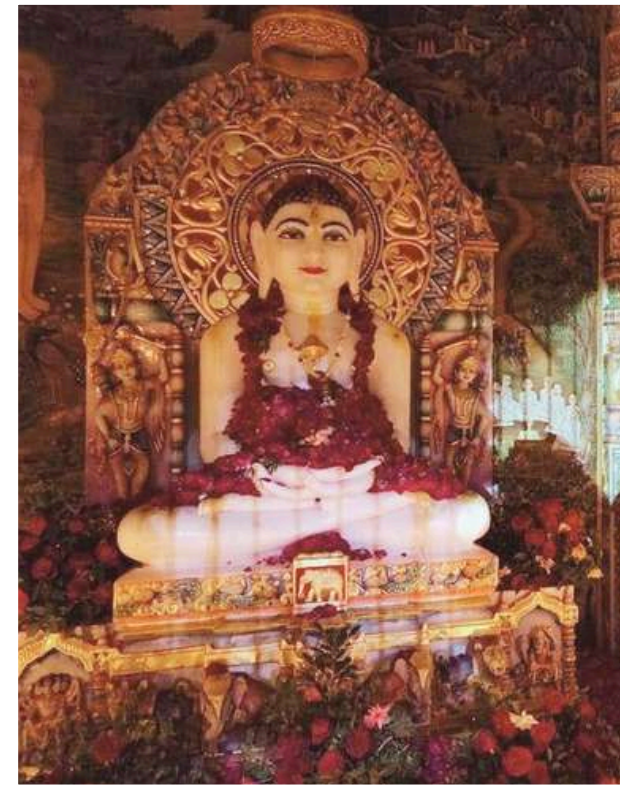
"We are not human beings having a spiritual experience; we are spiritual beings having a human experience." - Pierre Teilhard de Chardin
