



## **GIRNAR TIRTH 895th Salagiri Dhwaja** Vaishakh Sud Poonam

 Situated on the first plateau of Mount Girnar at the height of about 3800 steps, at an altitude of 2370 ft above Junagadh, still some 600 ft below the first summit of Girnar, there are Jain temples with marvellous carvings in marble.

 The mountain of Girnar is eternal like that of Shatrunjay. At the end of the 5th era, when the height of Shatrunjay will reduce to 7 arm lengths, Girnar will stand 100 Dhanush (400 arms) tall.

Girnar Tirth is said to be the 5th peak of Shatrunjay Tirth.
Girnar is the place where 10 Tirthankaras from the previous time cycle (Chovishi) attained Nirvan (Moksha)
Girnar is the place where three Kalyanaks of 22nd Tirthankar of the current time cycle Neminath Bhagwan took place – Diksha, Kevaljnana & Nirvan
Girnar is the place where all the 24 Tirthankaras of the next time cycle will attain Nirvan (Moksha)

• Girnar is the place which has the oldest idol of Neminath Bhagwan in the existing world.
