

# World Bee Day



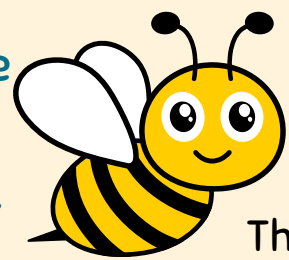
Protect our endangered pollinators

Honey bees wild and domestic perform about 80 percent of all pollination worldwide. A single bee colony can pollinate 300 million flowers each day. Grains are primarily pollinated by the wind, but fruits, nuts and vegetables are pollinated by bees. Seventy out of the top 100 human food crops which supply about 90 percent of the world's nutrition are pollinated by bees.



## Due to Climate Change

Warmer spring temperatures are causing bees to hatch earlier before flowers have bloomed for pollination.



Bees are vital in providing the balance between humans, plants, animals, and the environment.

According to the United Nation, Bees are endangered with close to one million species facing extinction. This could lead to far fewer apples, soft fruits, beans, tomatoes and more.



## Bees - Fun Facts

The average worker bee lives for just five to six weeks. During this time, she'll produce around a twelfth of a teaspoon of honey.



All worker bees are female.

The process of making honey is actually a way to store food for the bee colony

To produce a kilogram of honey, bees fly the equivalent of three times around the world in air miles.



The honey produced by each bee colony varies in color and taste, depending on the source of the nectar.

Bees constantly make honey because honey is their food.

A bee produces a teaspoon of honey (about 5 grams) in her lifetime.

The honey stored in the hive is preserved for years as a food reserve for the bee colony.

- Leave a small dish with a few pebbles and water for thirsty bees
- Reduce or completely cut out the usage of pesticides in gardens, as they're harmful to bees.
