10. Oshwal Association of the UK annually spends about £150K on the upkeep and maintenance of the Derasar – not just the temple, but the grounds as well. Whilst the Derasar plays a very important role for our centre, there is always a significant shortfall in the Derasar fund, and its upkeep costs are fulfilled from the Associations general income and donations. We have also spent a significant amount of money towards the canopy at the front of the derasar which again had to be funded from our general income and donations due to the shortfall in the collections.
